On Tuesday November 28, 2017 at approximately 2041 hours I, Officer Dimock responded to 1930 N. Grimes (Cattle Baron) in reference to a falsely obtaining services.

Upon arrival, I contacted the restaurant manager, Mary Jane Lowe and she advised a white male subject identified later as Bob Gallagher walked out without paying his bill. Mary informed me the total cost of the bill came out to \$41.07.

Items on the bill included three 22 ounce beers at \$4.75 each, West Coast Burger at \$10.25, glass of Pinot Grigio at \$3.00, Grand Marnier at \$9.00 and a scoop of ice cream at \$1.95 for a total of \$41.07 with tax included.

Mary stated Bob approached her at the desk near the front of the restaurant and stated, "I'm tired of waiting around to pay my bill." Mary advised me she told Bob she could take care of his bill for him and he stated "just bill me" and threw a card in her direction onto the floor. Mary advised me the card was a business card with his information on it.

Mary informed me Bob is a regular at the restaurant and sometimes acts rude towards the staff. Mary stated she did not know what type of vehicle Bob left in.

Mary was able to pull up a website on her phone and show me a photo of Bob. I recorded the photo with my bodyworn camera.

Mary also advised me she believed Bob to be a Jal City Councilman.

Mary was given a Victim's Rights card and advised on how to obtain a copy of this report. This matter was forwarded to the Hobbs City Attorney.
